Information for Grant Applicants

The Davis Education Fund of the North Carolina Unit of the Herb Society of America, Inc. offers modest grants (historically between \$50 and \$1000) for the purpose of supporting research and projects related to herbs. The following will be considered:

- Educational activities in North Carolina for members of the Unit or the general public, other than regular Unit meetings
- Scholarships and grants at an accredited North Carolina university, college, community college and secondary and/or elementary schools.
- Other programs or projects of an educational or outreach nature that will further the knowledge and use of herbs in North Carolina or elsewhere.

Grants are made on a one-time annual basis and subject to approval by a majority vote of the NC Unit, Herb Society of America, Board of Directors and approved by the members. Grant recipients to provide an accounting and explanation of the results of the project to the Davis Education Committee.

Grant proposals may be submitted anytime during the calendar year.

No grants will be considered related to the medicinal use of herbs in accordance unless in compliance with the practices and policies of the Herb Society of America, Inc.

A completed one-page application (following page) is required for consideration. In addition, the committee will take into consideration a one-page cover letter, photographs, or brochures if available and a limited amount of additional documentation.
